

Nottinghamshire County Council – DDA & Re-branding project

Notts County Council commissioned Caliba to manage the comprehensive re-brand of all buildings within its 174 site estate plus interpret the signage for visible DDA compliancy. After presenting solutions as a package of standard external and internal sign types, the project partners, Dykes Associates, surveyed all buildings in accordance with DDA guidelines.

Caliba put forward the information on a unique on-line database, which showed pictures of each site, sign drawings and visuals of the signs in situ. This allowed all client representatives to view the proposals for e-approval prior to manufacture. This new method of managing information for clients on substantial multi-site projects is a major breakthrough for project expediency and efficiency.

Signs were manufactured against the approved drawings, issued for installation by the installation partner, Robert Woodheads Ltd.
